

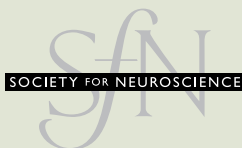

### Student Member Category II

A student member of the Society for Neuroscience in good standing as of Friday, October 12, 2007, who resides in a developing country with a lower-middle economy.

## Member Category II

A member of the Society for Neuroscience in good standing as of Friday, Oct. 12, 2007, who resides in a developing country with a lower-middle economy.

## Student Nonmember

A student working toward an undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral degree in neuroscience or an allied field qualifies for a reduced student rate. Student ID or proof of qualifying student status must be provided when registering on-site. Postdoctoral fellows, hospital residents, interns, and laboratory technicians, even though they may be in a training program, do not qualify for a reduced student rate.

## Housing

- A limited number of lower priced hotel rooms have been set aside for student and member category I & II registrants, available until Monday, Sept. 24. Hotels 35-48 are student and member category I & II hotels.
- Once registered for Neuroscience 2007, student and member category I & II registrants may reserve hotel rooms online, or by phone, fax, or mail.
- Rooms will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis until depleted or until Tuesday, Sept. 25 when these rooms will be released for general sale to all Neuroscience 2007 attendees.
- Only students and Member Category I and II attendees, their spouse, immediate family members, or registered guests of Neuroscience 2007 sponsored by a student or Member Category I and II occupant are permitted to occupy hotel rooms within this block.

**NOTE:** SfN will provide complimentary shuttle service to and from most SfN contracted hotels and the San Diego Convention Center during the annual meeting dates of Friday, Nov. 2 through Wednesday, Nov. 7, 2007. The shuttle routes and intervals of service will be posted on the Neuroscience 2007 Web site this summer.

## Transportation

### Airport Shuttle

Cloud 9 provides 24-hour airport transportation. The fares from the airport to downtown hotels is \$8.00, fare to Mission Valley is \$11.50, \$15.75 to the Coronado Island Marriott Resort, and to the Loews Coronado Resort \$15.75. Fares are per person, one way. When you arrive at the airport, claim your luggage and call Cloud 9 Shuttle from the airport courtesy phones located in the baggage claim. Return trips to the airport can be prearranged by dialing (800) 974-8885. ### Taxis



## Bus

The Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) public bus is available to the downtown area for a fare of \$2.25. The fare for a senior or disabled rider is \$1. Exact fares are required as the drivers cannot make change. Buses depart the airport for downtown approximately every 10 to 15 minutes. Buses travel downtown between 6 a.m. and Midnight. Day Tripper Passes are also available for \$5 per day, \$9 for two days, \$12 for three days, and \$15 for four days. For more information, please contact San Diego Transit at (800) COMMUTE.

## Trolley

Trolley fares are based on trip distance and are good for travel for two hours from the time of purchase and may be used to travel until the expiration time stamped on the ticket. Round-trip fares for the San Diego Trolley are generally from \$2.50 to \$6. The fare for senior and disabled riders is \$1.

# Free Offers

## Wireless Internet Access

As a service to its registrants, SfN will provide free, wireless Internet access in the San Diego Convention Center during Neuroscience 2007. Wireless Internet access will be available in the convention center lobbies and meeting rooms. Wireless Internet service will not be available in the exhibit halls or the poster session areas. Meeting attendees who wish to use this service should bring their own laptop computer, or PDA, with a built-in wireless network card or with an external wireless card that is 802.11a, 802.11b, or 802.11g compatible. Please be advised that technical support will not be provided. Users of the wireless network should reference the wireless Internet access FAQs and disclaimer information found in the Attendee Resources section of the Neuroscience 2007 Web site before accessing the network. We hope it serves as a valuable tool during your time in San Diego, California.

## NeuroJobs

Annual meeting attendees and exhibitors will have the opportunity to access job listings and schedule interviews with participating employers through the

Society's NeuroJobs Web site, [www.neurojobs.sfn.org](http://www.neurojobs.sfn.org), and on-site career center.

NeuroJobs Career Center will have computer workstations and printers with separate areas for both job seekers and employers. Job seekers will be able to use the computers to post resumes and view job listings. Employers will be able to post job openings and access resumes for a fee. Interview booths can be reserved for on-site interviews. The service will offer an informal and confidential setting for applicants and employers to meet.

### SfN/ANDP Hospitality Suite

The SfN/ANDP Hospitality Suite will be available for student registrants in the San Diego Convention Center. The room provides a relaxing area for reading and meeting with colleagues.

### Message Centers

SfN will provide several message centers for Neuroscience 2007 attendees in the San Diego Convention Center. Television monitors adjacent to each message center will scroll the names of the attendees who have unread messages. Please remember to check the monitors daily. If you are using a message center station as a place to meet colleagues, please be sure to identify at which message center you will be located.

The message center stations will remain open 24 hours a day during the annual meeting. After 5 p.m., the stations will not be staffed, so technical assistance will not be available until 8 a.m. the next morning. Messages can be posted as of Saturday, Nov. 3.

To log into the message center you will need to provide your email address (exactly as entered when registering for the meeting) and your badge number. Once logged in, attendees can set their individual message preferences. In addition to their name appearing on the message center monitors in the convention center; attendees can select to be notified by a text message, cell phone, or email when they receive a new message. Attendees that do not wish to receive messages can select not to have their information available.
