Nonmember

Anyone who is not a SfN member as of Friday, Oct. 17, 2008

Student Nonmember

A student working toward an undergraduate, graduate, or doctoral degree in neuroscience or an allied field qualifies for a reduced student rate. Student ID or proof of qualifying student status is required when registering on-site. Postdoctoral fellows, hospital residents, interns, and laboratory technicians, even in a training program, do not qualify for a reduced student rate.

Guest

A guest is a non-scientist family member or guest of a scientist. Guest registration fee includes a badge, admission to social events, and access to a scientific event for the sole purpose of observing the registered scientist's presentation. The following process and restrictions apply:

- A guest is only allowed to register once during the annual meeting.
- Include guest names on the annual meeting registration form.
- A maximum of two guests per registrant are allowed.
- Include the day of the registered scientist's presentation on the registration form. The day indicated will be printed on the guest's badge.
- Guests will be admitted to scientific events (including poster and slide sessions and the exhibit area) only on the day printed on the guest badge. Only one full day is permitted for the week of the annual meeting.
