

## MEMBERSHIP FACT SHEET

### Membership

The Society for Neuroscience is the largest professional society dedicated to the study of the nervous system, with nearly 42,000 members in the United States, Canada, Mexico, and more than 80 other countries.

### **Society Mission**

To advance the understanding of the brain and nervous system by bringing together scientists of diverse backgrounds, by facilitating the integration of research directed at all levels of biological organization, and by encouraging translational research and the application of new scientific knowledge to develop improved disease treatment and cures; to provide professional development activities, information, and educational resources for neuroscientists at all stages of their careers and increase participation of scientists from a diversity of cultural and ethnic backgrounds; to promote public information and general education about the nature of scientific discovery and the results and implications of the latest neuroscience research; and to inform legislators and other policymakers about new scientific knowledge and recent developments in neuroscience research and their implications for public policy, societal benefit, and continued scientific progress.

### **Membership Categories\***

- REGULAR Any person who has conducted research relating to neuroscience. Applications shall follow procedures defined by Council.
- REGULAR POSTDOC Any person who has obtained their doctoral degree and is currently working in a postdoctoral training program.
- STUDENT\*\* Any student enrolled in a program at a
  degree-granting institution of higher education. Eligibility for
  student membership shall terminate at the end of the first
  membership year in which the student is able to apply for
  another class of membership after completing or otherwise
  leaving the degree granting program. Former student
  members shall be eligible for election to another class of
  membership according to the same procedures and criteria
  as other scientific workers.
- AFFILIATE All persons interested in the Society's
  mission but not eligible for regular or student membership
  may apply for affiliate membership. Categories of affiliate
  membership shall be as defined in the Resolutions to
  Bylaws. Affiliate members are NOT entitled to submit
  abstracts for the annual meeting.

# YEAR 2014 REDUCED DUES COUNTRY LIST

To support neuroscientists and students residing in resource-restricted areas of the world and to encourage international participation in the Society and its programs, the Society for Neuroscience (SfN) offers reduced membership dues to residents of the countries listed below. The countries are divided into three categories using the World Bank's categorization of countries by income level. SfN's Reduced Dues Category I corresponds to the category of "low-income economies" (having a gross national income (GNI) per capita of \$1,035 or less). SfN's Reduced Dues Category II includes countries in the category of "lower-middle-income economies" (having a GNI per capita of \$1,036-\$4,085). SfN's Reduced Dues Category III includes countries in the category of "upper-middle-income economies" (having a GNI per capita of \$4,086-\$12,615). The World Bank updates these lists annually and SfN makes adjustments as needed. Reductions and categories are based on an individual member's work and residence address. Members working and/or residing outside these geographical locations will be required to pay full membership dues.
