

Managing Event Pilot App Alerts


When initially installing the Neuroscience 2016 mobile app, it will ask you if you want to accept Notifications from this app.





Accepting this option by clicking "OK" will allow you to see alert messages from the association, such as Session Room changes, room overflow options, and other information to help you stay up-to-date on program changes and important announcements. See image below. If you would not like to get such notifications, then select "Don't Allow" at the app's initial launch.



If, at a later time, you change your mind about allowing (or not allowing) the app notifications, you can manage this by clicking on the "Login Settings" tab at the bottom of the screen as indicated by the red arrow in the image above. Then, scroll down and click "Open Settings" as indicated in the image below. This will take you to the device Settings and allow you to change the setting for the Notifications for this particular mobile app.








If you happen to see a red number over the Alerts button on the app Home page indicating an active alert, or wish to view an alert again, click this button to view a list of the current alerts, and click on any individual alert to read the detail. See image below. These alerts can be permanently dismissed by clicking the "X" in the upper right hand corner, or you can close this list by clicking on the "X" on the "Close Alert Window" bar.

Although the example images are shown using an Apple device, the app is controlled similarly on Android devices.
