



# November Graduate School and Career Fair FAQs

## What is the Virtual Graduate School and Career Fair?

The Virtual Graduate School and Career Fair is a three-day event that will provide job seekers and prospective students with a unique opportunity to connect one-on-one through live text and video chat with employers, departments, and programs. During the event, attendees will click to enter booths of interest. Once there, attendees can initiate a conversation with staff at the booth and read through profiles of employers, departments, and programs.

## When will the event be held?

The Virtual Graduate School and Career Fair will be held November 5–7, 2020, with core hours of 12–3 p.m. EST. These core hours are when SfN staff and technical assistance will be guaranteed to be available, and when exhibitors are recommended to be at their booths. Attendees and exhibitors will be able to access the Virtual Career Fair at all hours during the event; however, SfN cannot guarantee staff or technical assistance outside of the core hours.

Attendees will have access to this event until Tuesday, November 10, 2020.

## Will the Virtual Graduate School Fair and Virtual Career Fair be held as two separate events?

No, the Virtual Graduate School and Career Fair will be able to be accessed through the same platform. One link will direct you to all graduate schools and employers. However, attendees can filter searches for grad schools or employers based on their interests.

## What employers, programs, and departments are exhibiting at the Virtual Graduate School and Career Fair?

To view exhibitors, click on 'Exhibitors', then 'Browse All Exhibitors' on the left-hand navigation on the fair's main page. You can also download a list of all exhibitors by clicking 'Download Exhibitor List' in the left-hand navigation.

## How do I set up my user profile for the event?

Once logged in, click on your name in the upper-right hand corner of your screen. Then click on 'My Conference Profile' to update your profile.
